

Donate to help HRC replace and upgrade our fleet!

To better serve our members, and enhance our fitness and competitive programs, Halifax Rowing Club needs to replace and upgrade its fleet. By supporting the HRC Equipment Fund you can help to make this happen!! We are looking to raise \$45,000 over the next 3 years!

*Donations of more than \$20.00, made to the National Sport Fund Trust – **Project HRC Equipment Fund**, are tax deductible and will be used to purchase new rowing shells, oars and/or coach boats and motors.*

HRC Equipment Fund

In order to continue to serve the wider Halifax community, and its current and future members, Halifax Rowing Club needs to maintain and upgrade its fleet of rowing shells. With new rowing shells costing from \$12,000 – \$30,000 each, finding the funds to do this is an on-going challenge.

In past years, HRC has used grants to fund the purchase of new and used shells. We have also borrowed funds from financial institutions, partnered with RowNS, and used monies raised through fees charged to our members.

And while this approach has allowed us to purchase some new-to-us shells, and fund necessary maintenance, we need an influx of funds to replace our oldest, most well-used shells and purchase additional new shells, oars and other equipment needed to meet the needs of our growing youth and adult programs.

The HRC Equipment Fund has been set up as a fundraising project under the umbrella of the National Sport Fund Trust (NSFT). Those who donate more than \$20 can receive a charitable tax receipt.

What is the Goal of the HRC Equipment Fund?

The goal of HRC Equipment Fund is to raise **\$45,000 over the next three years.**

How does the HRC Equipment Fund Work?

Anyone can donate money to the Fund. Donations are made directly to the NSFT, and the NSFT is requested to assign these funds to the HRC Equipment Fund Project. As funds accumulate, HRC can receive money from the NSFT to cover the costs associated with the purchase of shells, oars, and coach boats/motors.

Those wishing to donate money can do so in a number of ways.

- 1) Download and complete the HRC Equipment Fund donation form and mail the form and a cheque directly to the Nova Scotia Chapter of the NSFT.
- 2) Download and complete the donation form and then drop off your donation (cash or cheque) and the form at the NSFT offices.
- 3) Donate online through the link on our website, halifaxrowing.ca.

In-kind donations:

Those wishing to make in-kind donations (e.g. donate new or used rowing shells, oars, coach boats or motors) can do so and receive a tax receipt for the value of the item being donated.

If items are new, a receipt showing the costs of the item must be provided as proof of the market value of the item.

Used items valued at more than \$1000 must have been independently appraised to confirm the fair market value of the donation.
